- The North Central West Virginia Airport in Clarksburg, WV (CKB) (small airport 30 minutes away)
- The Morgantown Municipal Airport in Morgantown, WV (MGW) (small airport 40 minutes away) The Yeager Airport in Charleston, WV (medium sized airport 1.5 hours away)

Bus Lines

Public transportation locally is offered by 1 bus line

The FMCTA offers courtesy stops. This means that no matter where you are located (on FSU campus or off) along a route, you can simply waive your hand at the approaching bus and it will stop for you. Drop-offs are handled this same way simply indicate to the bus driver when you board where you would like to be dropped off.

- The NEW Transfer Station (located downtown) on the corner of Jefferson and Monroe Streets serves as a "hub" for FMCTA transit. Many connections can be made here and it is possible to reach the location on foot from campus, setting aside adequate time for the walk.
- There is no dedicated FMCTA stop on FSU campus, but most students use the park bench located on Bryant Street, between the parking garage and Bryant Place residence hall. You may catch the bus (or be dropped off) ANYWHERE on campus, as long as you're on an outer sidewalk on one of following surrounding roads:
 - o Locust Avenue (in front of school)
 - o Bryant Street (to right of school)
 - o Squibb Wilson Blvd. (to left of school)
- At 15 minutes past EVERY hour, the FMCTA bus referred to as the "Edgemont Loop" arrives on campus. This route is a great one and includes stops on Country Club Road, as well as Fairmont Ave., where many businesses and restaurants are located.
- An FMCTA route called the 'FSU Mall' leaves at 6:00PM from the Transfer Station Middletown Mall (including several restaurants there) and to the **nearby Wal-Mart and its shopping center.** This is the last bus mall area that will return via Locust Ave.!
